4. Update from around the table

This agenda item has been added as it was thought a good idea going forwards, to allow updates from each member region. This will be a standing agenda item and each representative is encouraged to come with an update.

MH reported that In France there's been a lot of work on national infrastructures pushing the FAIR agendas; opportunities there for OneGeology. Internally at BRGM, the long-term tech representative has changed. Nicolas Mauroy has moved onto a new role and Olivier Frezot has taken over Olivier introduced himself and gave a short introduction. OneGeology would like to recognise the fantastic job that Nicolas has done whilst working on the project and thank him for his input into the OOG Meetings. Also, to welcome Olivier on board, we look forward to working with him.

MH said that the GIC had met last month in Prague, which had been a great opportunity for directors of informatics to meet. Physical meetings are starting back up.

5. Digital GeoScience Workshop Update (MH)

Dates chosen; 6th-10th November. In conjunction with Deep Time Digital Earth science programme, which launches on 9th November in Paris. This will be a good opportunity to discuss evolving perspectives from the last two years and what we can do going forward. MH shared a prospective agenda that includes a series of formal and informal introduction sessions and presentations to get the new geosciences involved.

It is intended that invitations will be circulated in the next few weeks and is hoped for a high number of physical attendees, as this allows more interactivity than a webinar style session. HD advised that he's unsure anyone from CPRM would be able to attend, but he will try and find more info. SH says GeoScience Australia would be interested in attending. Trying to set up an email address so interest for attendance can be formally gauged

6. GeoInfo summit (MH)

MH explained that this is about using a physical meeting to springboard getting the new scientists involved in these discussions. Exploring sustainability goals, which leads into Digital Twins and how that can contribute towards this.

CGI planning to have a virtual workshop in September. It is hoped that with the physical workshop we can form some ideas to link all the science committees together. All global initiatives can be slightly slow to react and we need to change this. There is a need to be looking and planning five years ahead

7. Updates on Digital Twin working group (RT)

RT explained that currently, there has been one formal meeting plus a further informal meeting, of the DTWG. This has involved general discussions about what is a Digital Twin and what is the interest in them. The group agreed a plan of action developed and RT has developed a landing page on the new OneGeology website regarding Digital Twins. This explains what a Digital Twin is and what are OneGeology is doing with these initiatives and projects.

RT explained that we are now creating a catalogue of DT's, this includes 5 general themes which are mostly tech heavy currently. He said that we are looking for input from various countries' so it's not just BGS putting information in on behalf of other countries from our 'geo' interests. THE DTWG will meet again soon and discuss what can be presented at the GeoScience Workshop.

8. Finance and Membership (VTH)

VTH reported that the Membership subscriptions are on track for this year. We will do a membership drive once the website is agreed and deployed

9. Communication and Outreach (VTH)

- JP gave a presentation of the new updated OneGeology Website. VTH apologised for not sharing the link prior to the meeting but explained that it currently sits on an internal server.
- The feedback in the group was Positive for the website and all agreed it can go live

AGREED: The group agreed that the website can go live once VTH has had go ahead from the BGS cultural lead.
