#### 5. Digital GeoScience Workshop Update (MH)

MH advised the November workshop has unfortunately been postponed, but he is hoping the move the workshop to spring 2023. The aim is to be inclusive of as many of the different global initiatives as possible. We will begin the planning of the event sooner to allow more people to travel in person, although, the event will be hybrid.

MH said that there is a UNESCO 9<sup>th</sup> Nov Event Open GeoScience DGE open science forum in Paris on Nov 9<sup>th</sup> and BRGM are intending to have an event on 7<sup>th</sup> Nov (in Paris with 50-80 people) which will focus around data driven geoscience, deep type digital. He has a meeting about this later today so will update group and provide an update at the steering group meeting.

## 6. GeoInfo summit (MH)
