OneGeology condemns the Russian government's invasion of Ukraine and calls for a stop to any more senseless loss of life. We are shocked and saddened by the humanitarian crisis.

OneGeology has always prided itself in collaborating with colleagues across the globe, but taking our lead from the <u>International Science Council</u> the <u>Joint Statement by the G7</u> and in National Governments' guidance, we have taken the unprecedented step of suspending all activities with research organisations in Russia and Belarus. We join other organizations globally that are acting to bring about an end to this aggression and to restore peace and acknowledge Russian scientists and citizens who have spoken out against this war.

Given the rapidly changing situation we will continue to evaluate our position on an ongoing basis. Our thoughts remain with everyone affected including colleagues and academic partners who may be dealing directly or indirectly with the effects.
